

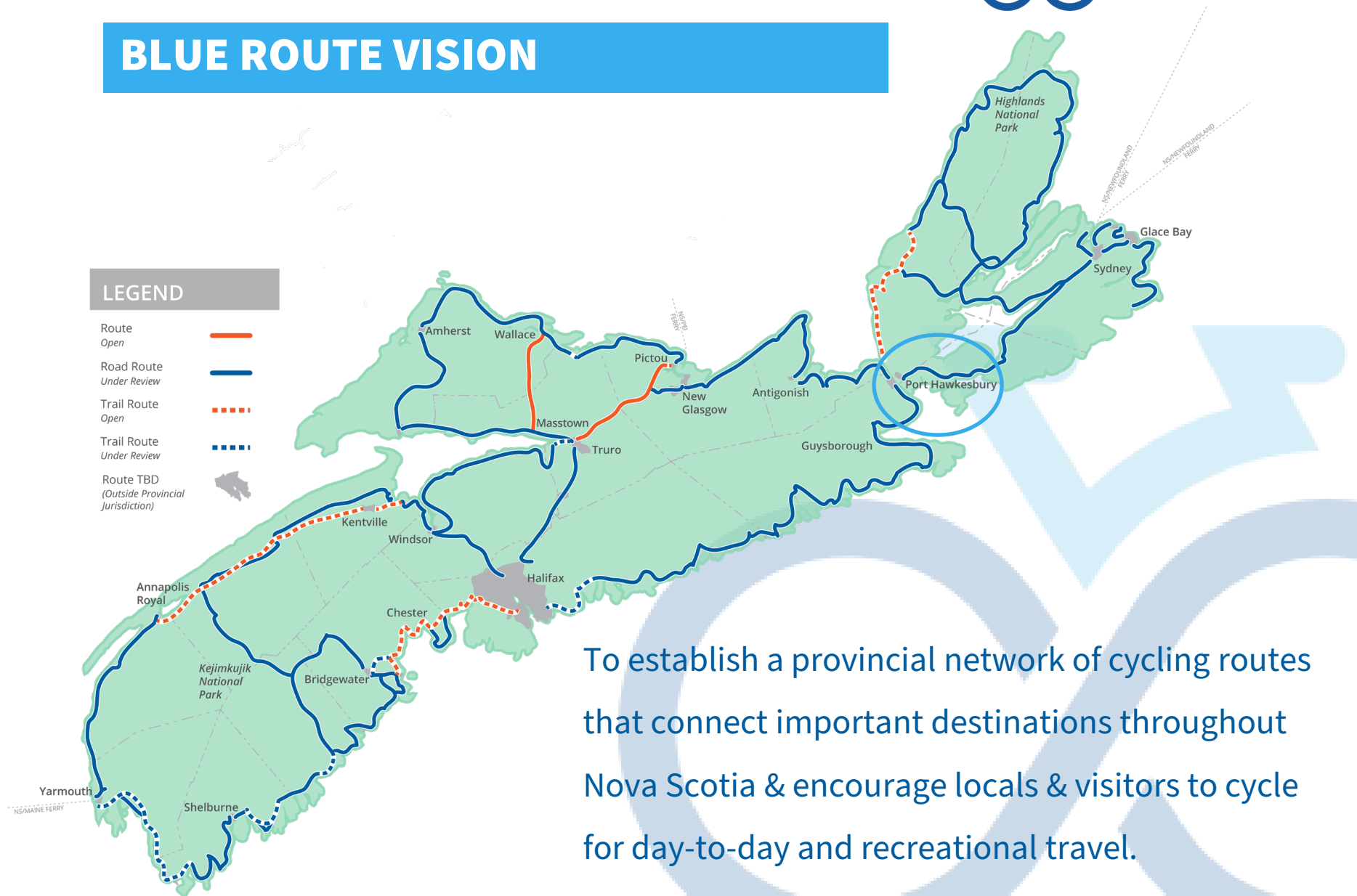

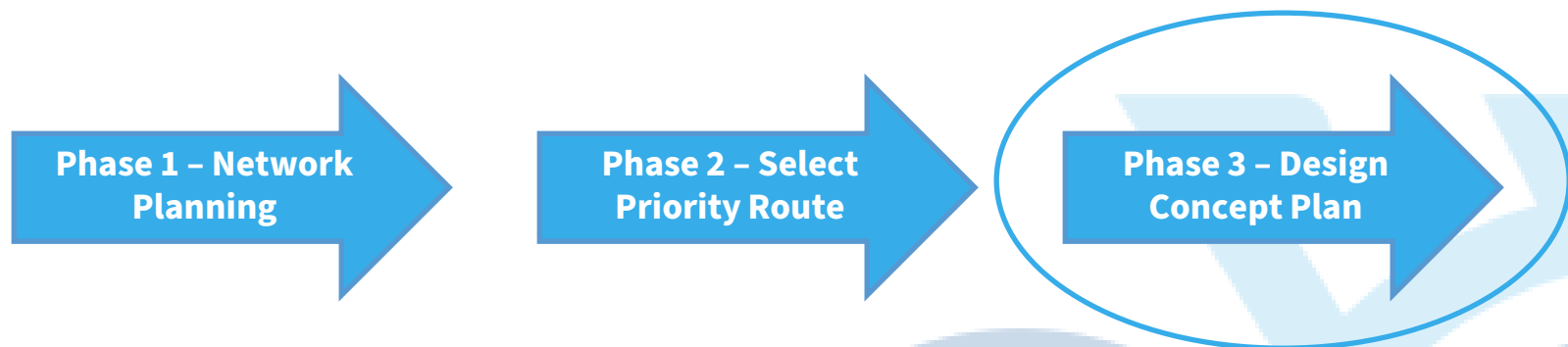


BLUE ROUTE VISION

- **Connect** provincial Blue Route to local attractions

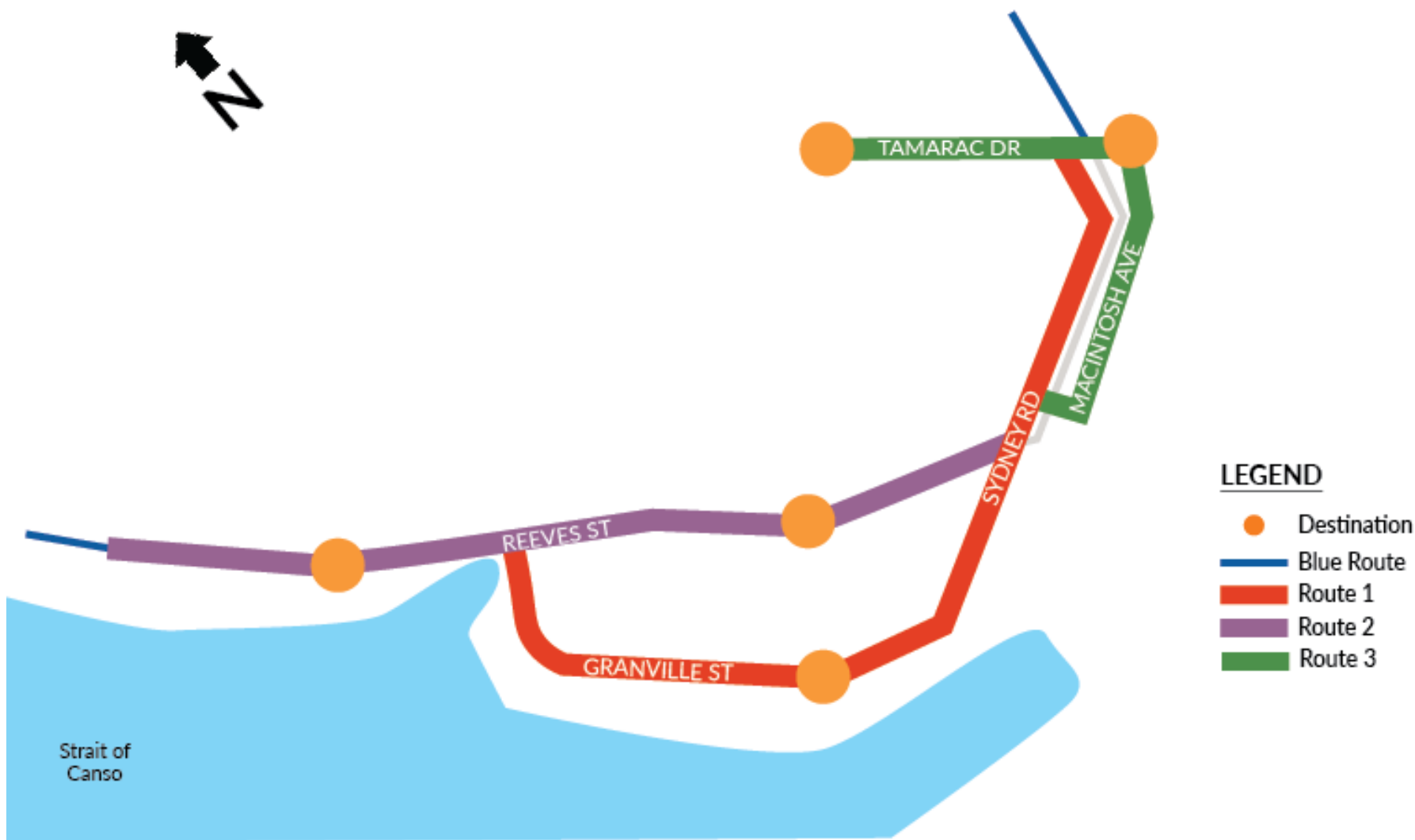
ALL AGES & ABILITIES

Blue Route Hub Bikeway Study: Port Hawkesbury



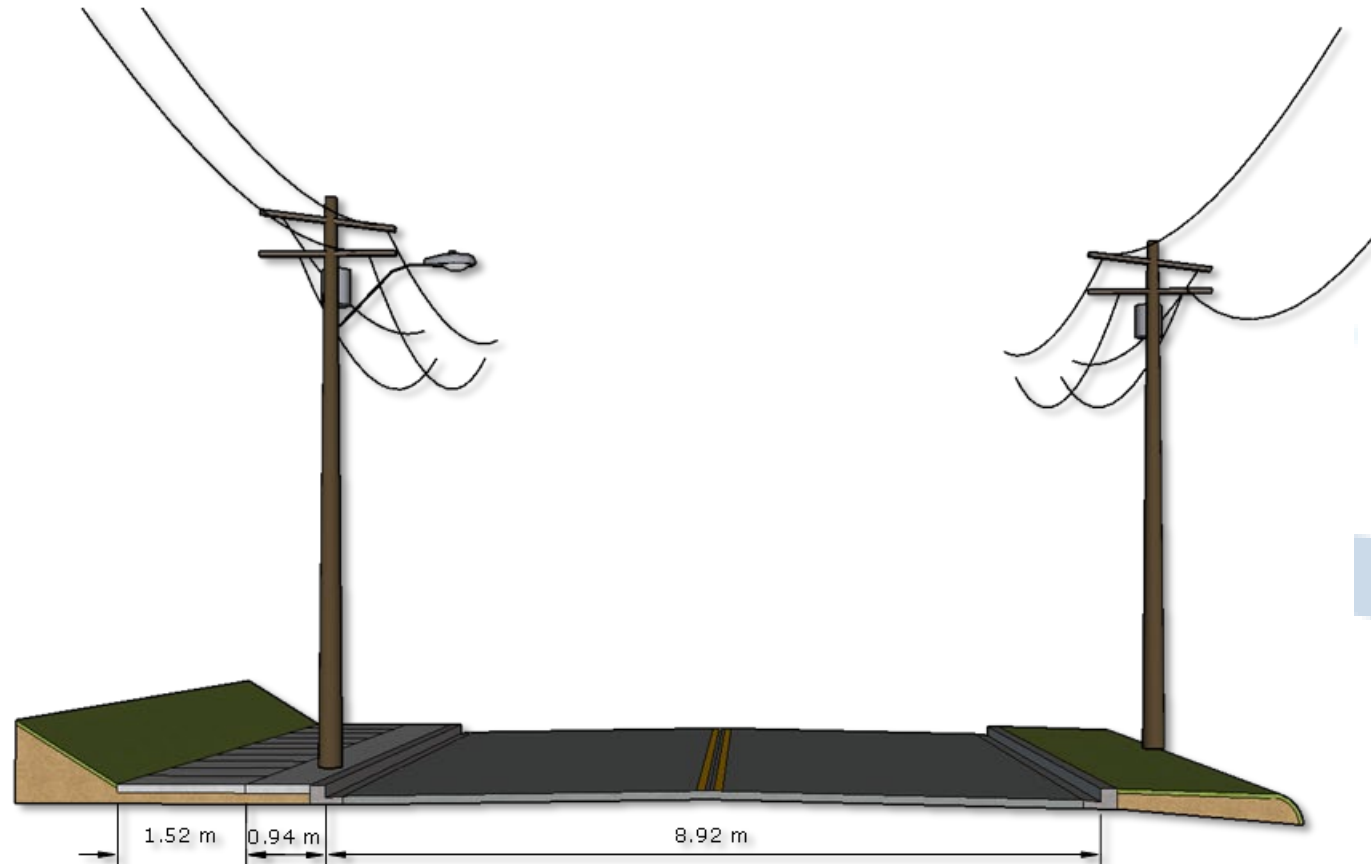

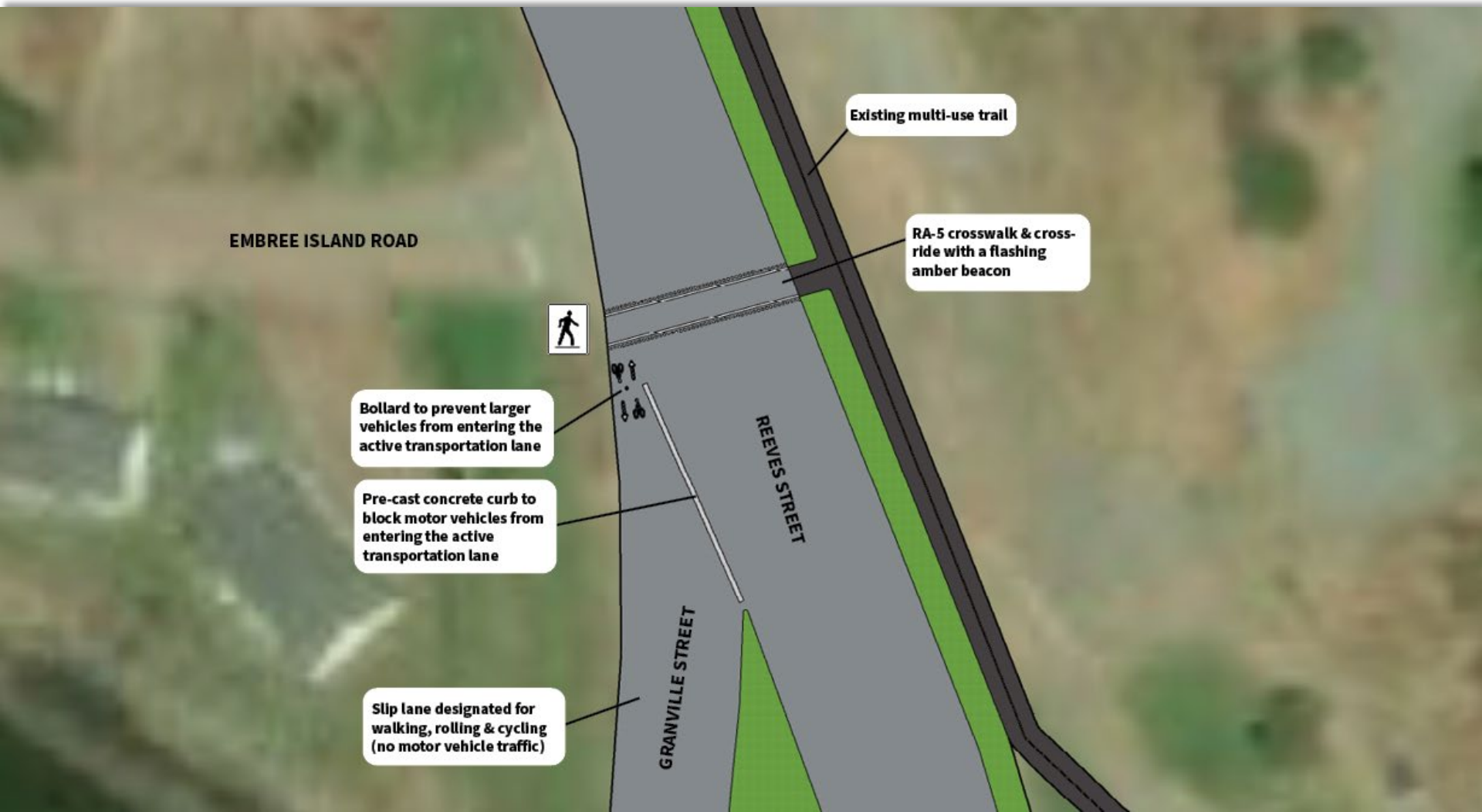
Concept: Multi-use Pathway

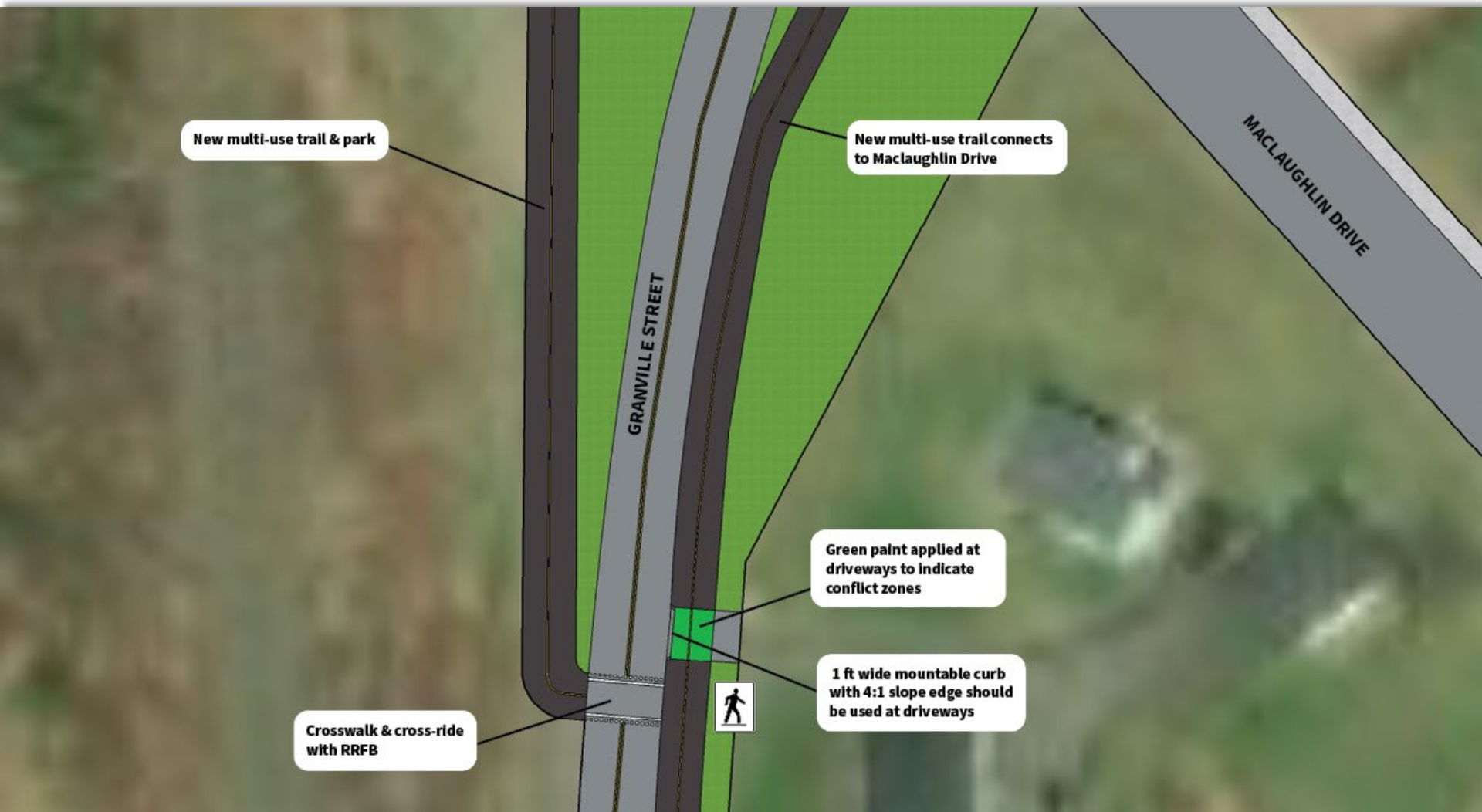

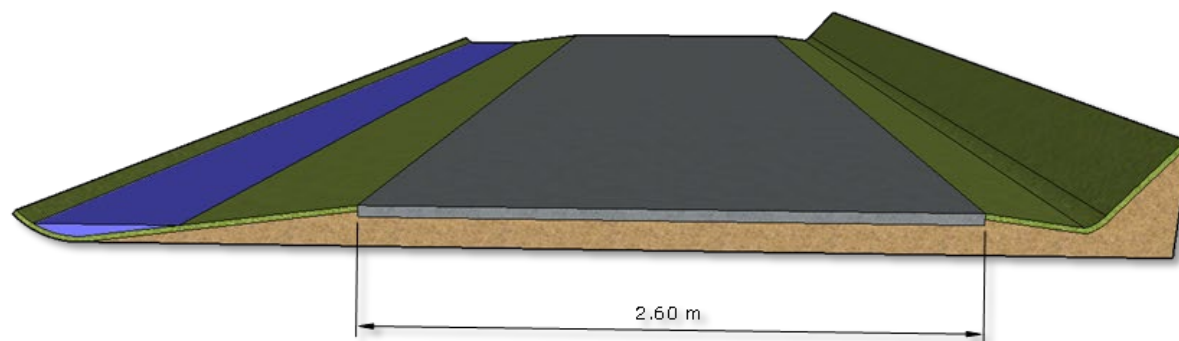

Concept: Widened & repaved multi- use pathway



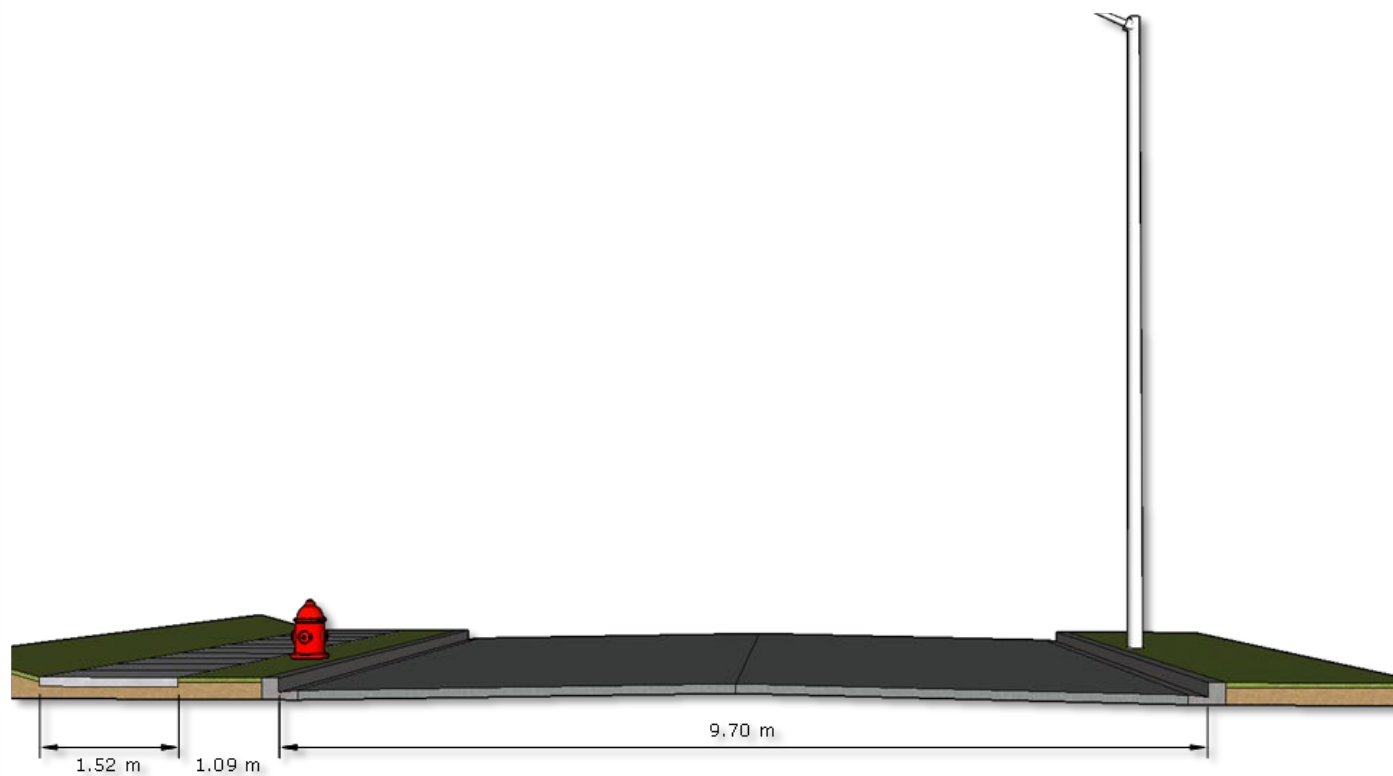

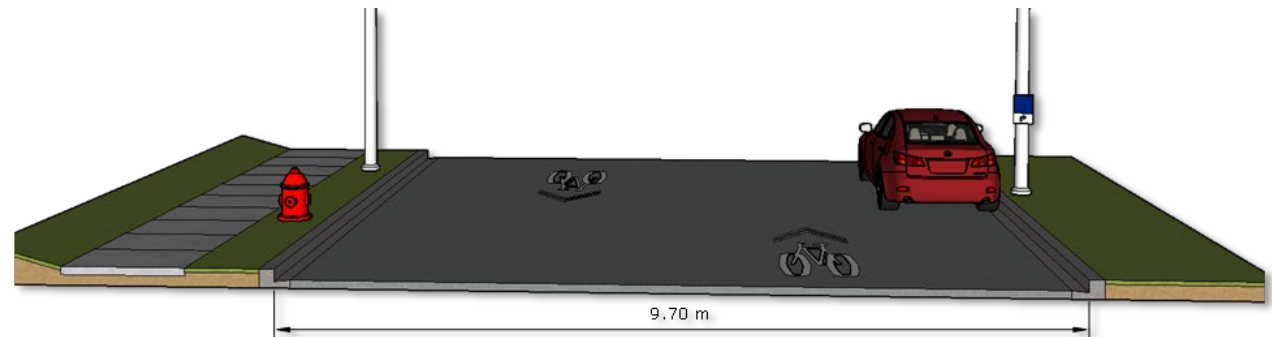
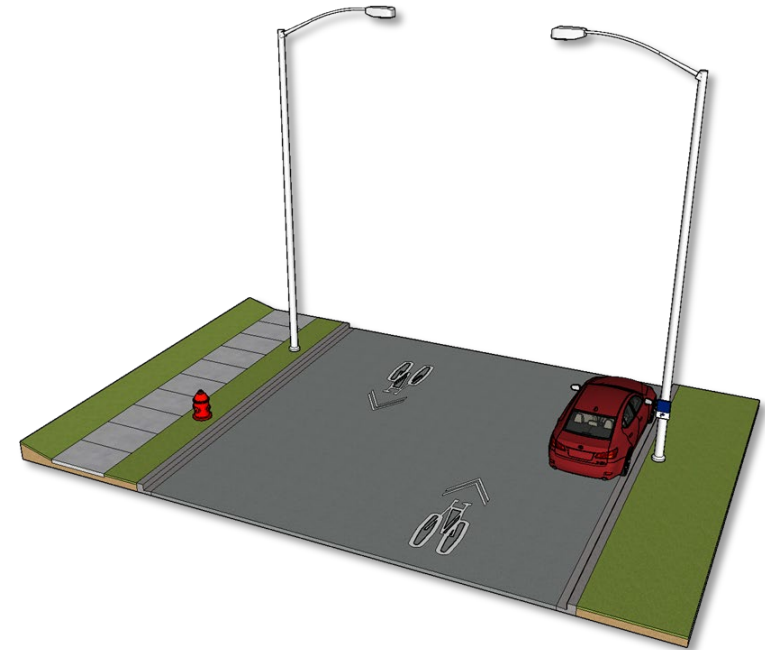
